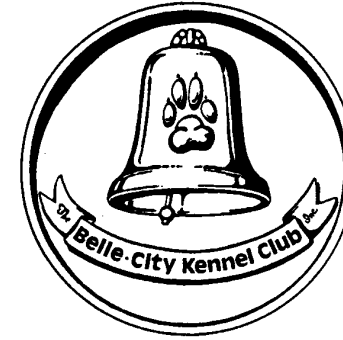

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

**THE TRIAL SITE will be available at 7:30 am on Saturday July 23, 2011 and at 7:00 am on Sunday, July 24, 2011. Dogs must be removed from the Trial site immediately following the conclusion of the judging.**

**CRATING in designated areas only. CRATE SPACE IS LIMITED. X-pens will not be allowed in the building. There will be no space for un-entered dogs at these trials.**

**No RV or Overnight parking allowed at the Trial Site.**

**MAIL ALL ENTRIES WITH FEES** several days in advance of the closing date. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practicable with entry identification cards and judging program. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary.

**MAKE ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO Belle-City Kennel Club, Inc.**

**A RECORDING FEE** of \$0.50 and a \$3.00 Event service Fee will be required for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in all AKC licensed club events. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2 Rules Applying to Dog Shows) A recording fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry of each dog entered in any Rally Trial.
